Bus Parking and Directions

Pick-up/Drop-off Instructions for School Groups Arriving by Bus

A drop-off and pick-up-lay-by is designated immediately to the right of the campus entrance. Buses unload here. Visitors proceed on foot north to 4600 Bathurst Street, one half-block from the traffic light. Please buzz Security on the intercom to enter.

Buses may wait in the lay-by or proceed to the security booth at the bottom of the hill for further instructions on where to wait and/or turn around and exit the site.


You may meet your group at the bus lay-by after their visit.

Students must remain in the museum and its immediate vicinity and may not congregate in the Lipa Green lower lobby.

Buses will not be permitted to enter past the Sherman Campus Security.

Please obey instructions of security guards.

Directions

The Neuberger Holocaust Education Centre and Museum is located on Sherman Campus in the Lipa Green Centre, 4600 Bathurst Street, west of Bathurst between Sheppard and Finch Avenues.

Driving North on Bathurst Street

After crossing Sheppard Avenue on Bathurst Street northbound, turn LEFT at the third set of stoplights onto Sherman Campus.

Driving South on Bathurst Street

After crossing Finch Avenue on Bathurst Street southbound, turn RIGHT at the third set of stoplights onto Sherman Campus.

Directions by TTC:

The museum is accessible by TTC.

- From the Bathurst subway station: #7 Bathurst North bus
- From Wilson Station: # 160 Bathurst North bus
- From Sheppard Station: #84 Sheppard West, then transfer to a Bathurst North bus.
- From Downsview Station: #84 Sheppard West, then transfer to a Bathurst North bus.

Buses will drop you off on Bathurst, just south of the Bathurst Street entrance to the building. Proceed up the hill by foot on the west side of the street and enter at the doors. Please buzz Security on the intercom to enter.
